RULES ON VOTER IDENTIFICATION
(pursuant to Act 595 of 2013)

Beginning January 1, 2014, voters are required to provide photo identification (ID) in order to vote.

If you don't have any of the types of photo ID shown below, contact the Washington County Clerk's Office to get a FREE voter ID card before going to the polls.

**DOCUMENTS OR IDENTIFICATION CARDS THAT
COMPLY WITH NEW REQUIREMENTS**

1. An Arkansas driver's license with your photo
2. A photo ID card issued by the state of Arkansas or the Federal government
3. An Arkansas concealed handgun carry license with your photo
4. A United States (US) passport with your photo
5. An employee ID from an Arkansas or US government agency with your photo
6. A US military or Veterans ID with your photo
7. A student or employee ID issued by an accredited postsecondary educational institution in the state of Arkansas with your photo
8. A voter ID card with your photo issued by the County Clerk's Office
9. A public assistance identification card with photo

**If your ID has an expiration date, it must be current or expired no more than four years before the date of the election.*
